Pamplona - Baluarte


The BALUARTE Conference Centre and Auditorium of Navarra (Pamplona) is the benchmark in the Autonomous Community both in hosting MICE and cultural activities.

Baluarte is one of the largest Conference Centres in Spain, with a total area of 63,000 m², including two floors of underground parking with capacity for 900 vehicles.

A large space capable of hosting events of different kinds, BALUARTE is a building built by the Government of Navarre, the work of the Navarrese architect Patxi Mangado. Baluarte is located in the centre of the city, next to the Citadel of Pamplona, an old fortress from the 16th century converted into a large green area.

03. The venues: welcome reception

Ciudadela

Ciudadela is a Renaissance fortification in the shape of a pentagon with bastions and ravelins, begun by Philip II according to the project of the military engineer Giovan Giacomo Paleari Fratino, known as "El Fratín". In 1964 it was ceded to the City Council to create a public cultural and leisure space. A space of 280,000 square metres whose pavilions, moats, bastions, ravelins, fortifications, minor buildings and glacis are today public places for leisure, sport and culture. The Citadel, Pamplona's urban landmark, is also considered the best example of military architecture of the Spanish Renaissance and one of the most outstanding defensive complexes in Europe.




Bioenergy
