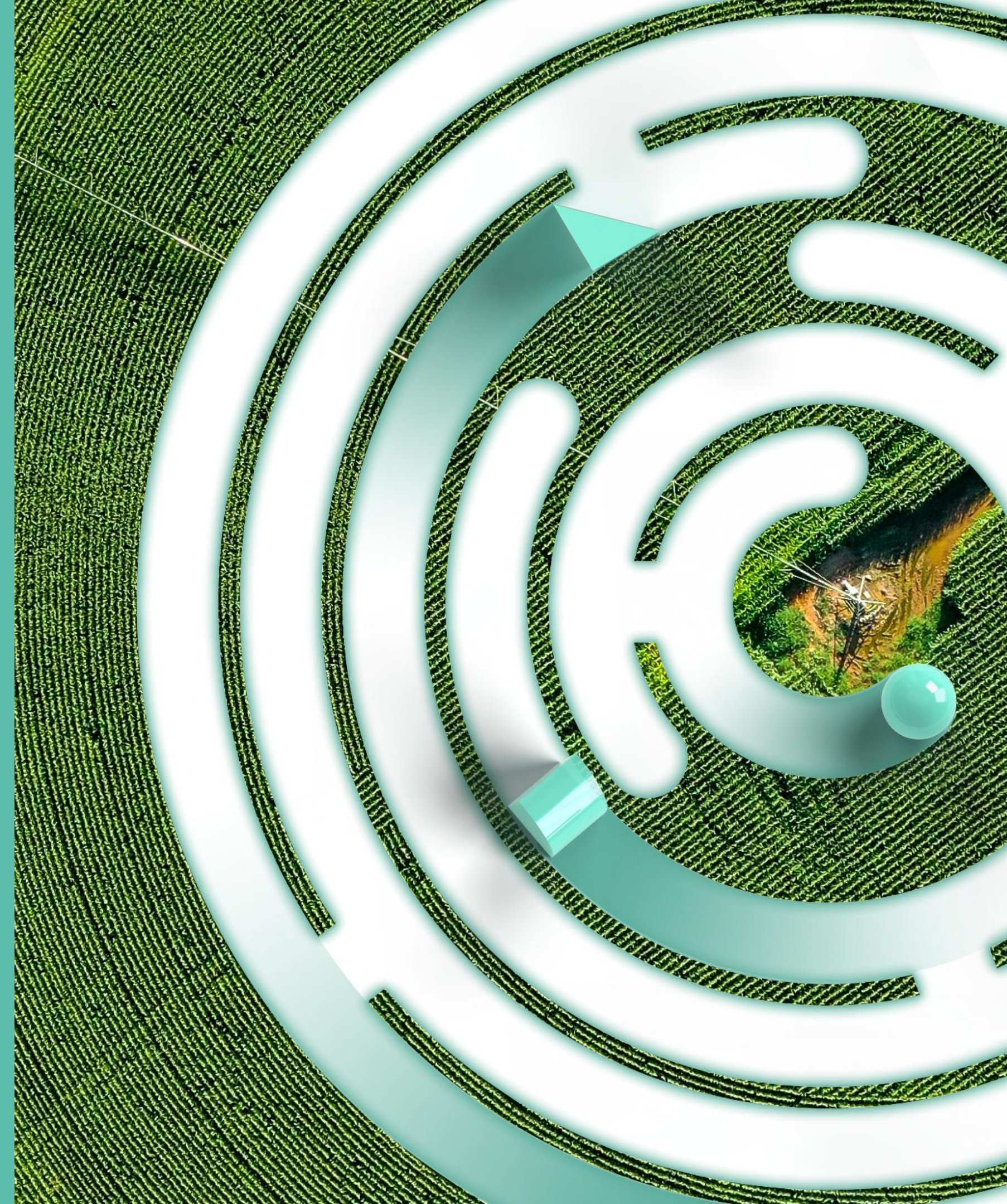

01. Concept of the event

Organised by AseBio, the Spanish Bioindustry Association, the Green Innovation Forum is a biennial independent event aligned with the 2030 Agenda and the European Green Deal, showcasing how biotechnology accelerates the transition towards a more sustainable and climate neutral economy.

With a strong applied focus, it gathers innovators and stakeholders across agri food biotech, agriculture, sustainability, food industry and supplements, bioenergy, fermentation, bioprocessing, veterinary and animal health, among other fields.

The programme combines expert round tables panels, start up pitch and business partnering, bringing together industry, academia, investors and the public sector.

Networking starts with an evening reception on 20 April, followed by the full day Forum on 21 April, which will conclude with a curated tasting of innovative products, designed to showcase how biotech is reaching the market.

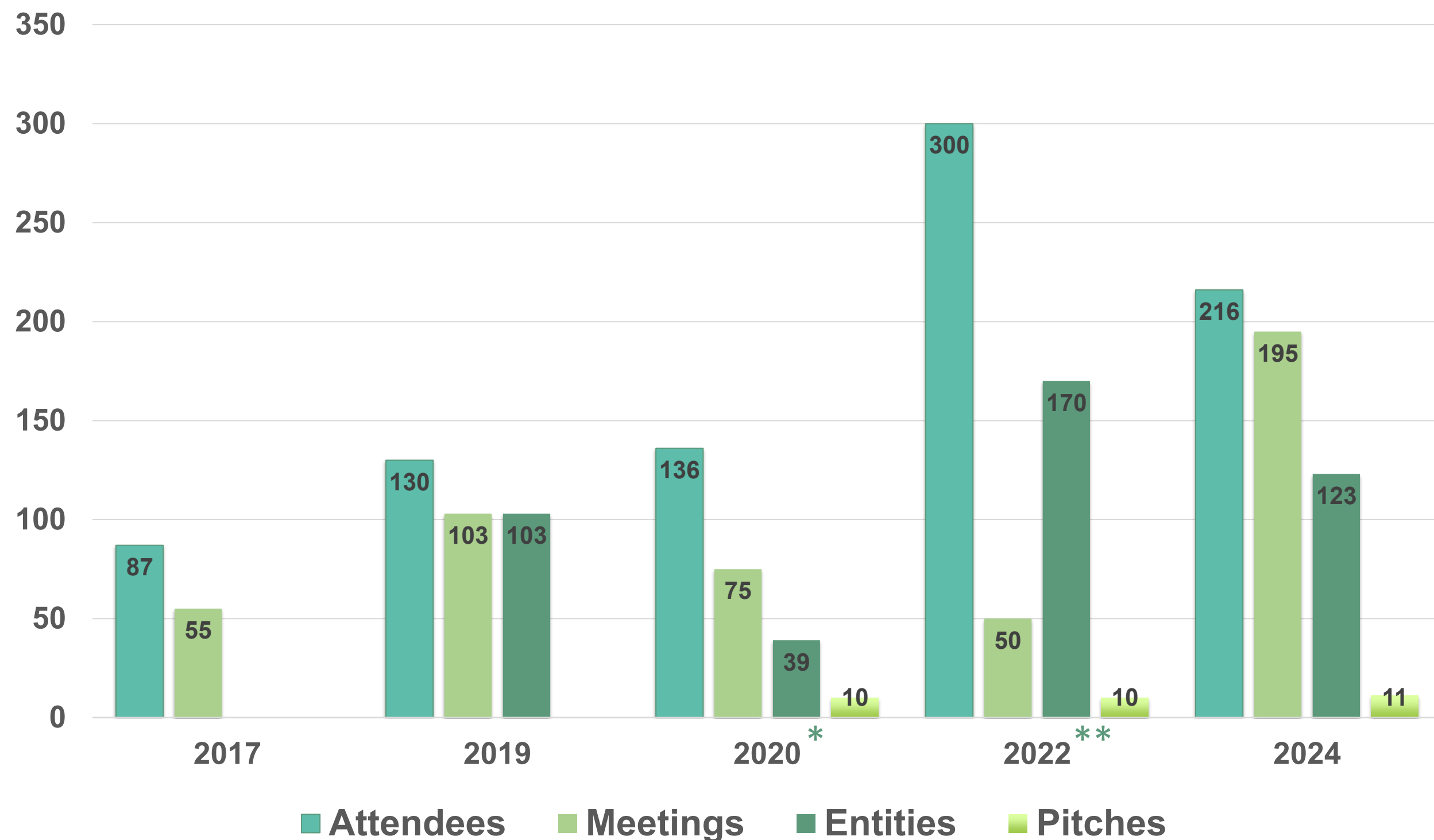
Consolidation of the event

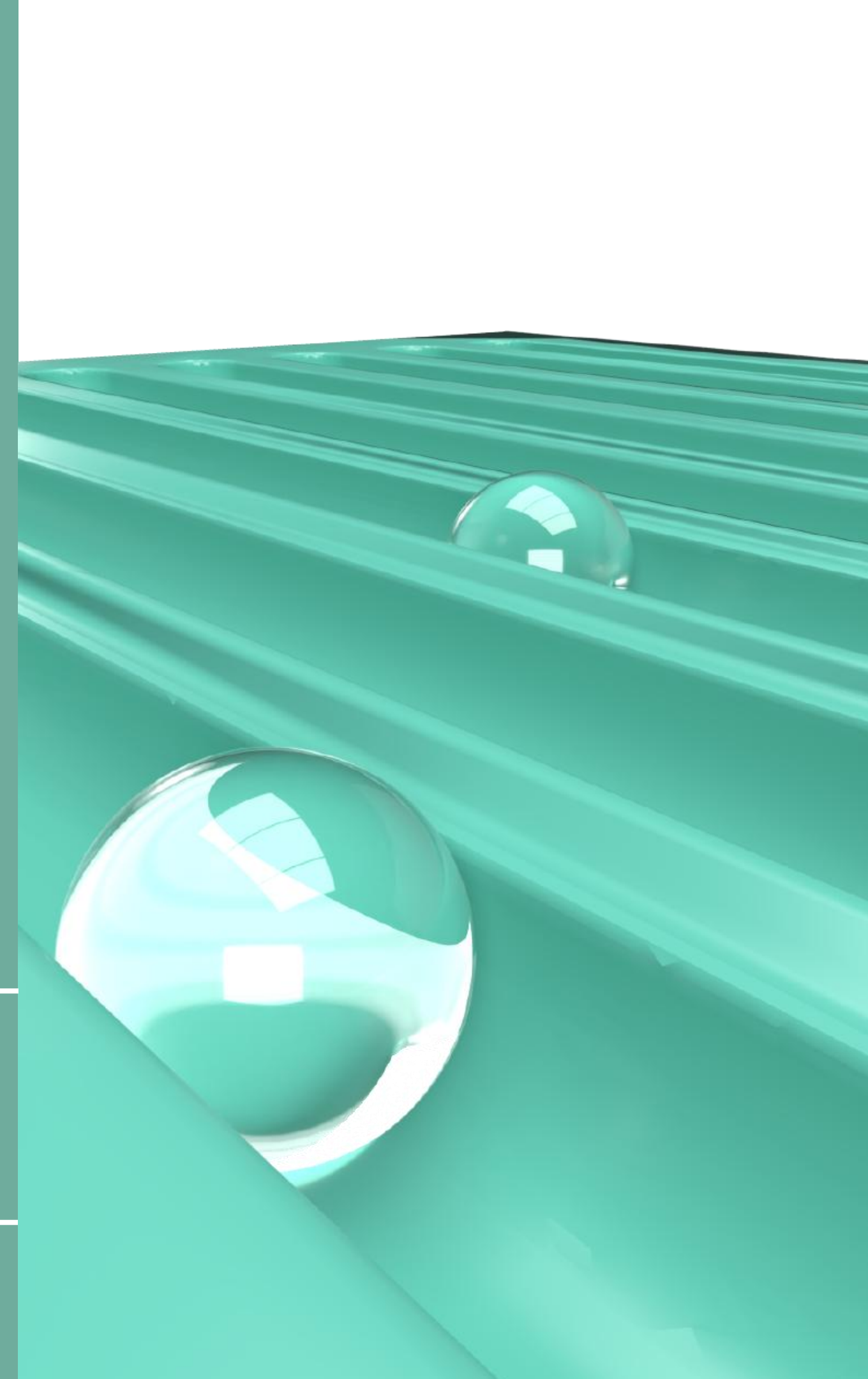
